

IMPACT

In 2018, Tiny Hero helped 105 families seeking expert CDH medical care, at 48 different hospitals. After receiving a CDH diagnosis, many families will need to temporarily relocate their families to find life saving care at a hospital equipped to treat CDH. It's not uncommon for a CDH family to spend upwards of \$25,000 out of pocket to give their baby the best chance of life. Tiny Hero is there to help these families bridge this financial gap, but we need your help.
